Welcome to the 8th Annual Report of HF Connecting Health Nurse Practitioner-Led Clinic (Clinic). More than a year later, the world is still grappling with the COVID-19 pandemic, but there is hope the Ontario interventions are strengthening our road to recovery. We hope you and your families are staying healthy and safe. We thank you for your ongoing support and trust in the Clinic; together we Care and Connect to navigate these unpredictable, challenging times. The Clinic interdisciplinary team has demonstrated resilience during the pandemic by upholding our Mission, Vision and Values to provide primary care for individuals, families and the community:

- The Clinic remains open with weekday hours and infection control precautions for the health and safety of clients; onsite team members manage lockdowns and stay-at-home orders
- Safe connections support individuals and families managing COVID-19 testing and/or isolation precautions at home
- Health workshops and events enhance social connectedness and help cope with anxiety and depression; at times, in addition to English, events are presented in a language relevant to the client group
- Transformation of care delivery introduce tele-visits, virtual care via Telemedicine network, and the ZOOM platform which continue to support physical and mental wellbeing
- Educational webinars in collaboration with community and Ontario Health Team (OHT) partners about COVID-19 and vaccine hesitancy
- Laptops, smart phones, printers and reconfigured VPN support the transition of team members to work remotely and serve the clients effectively

We are thankful for generous donations from Ontario Health, the City of Toronto, United Way of Greater Toronto, local politicians, donors and supporters who addressed gaps for clients by providing grocery cards, smart phones and data plans, and provided staff with personal protective equipment (PPE) such as masks, gloves and gowns.

We remain committed to Equitable Access to Quality Primary Care and in the coming year there will be:

- Development and implementation of 55+ Fit Program with new funding from New Horizons for Seniors Small Grant
- Kick off for Strategic Plan 2021-2024
- Refresh of Emergency Preparedness and Business Continuity Plan to include learning from the pandemic and additional best practices
- Development of Clinic Recovery Plan Beyond the COVID-19 Pandemic as the pandemic legacy could be deeper and longer-lasting than anticipated

Message from Our Lead Nurse Practitioner— Cheuk Fai Law

This past year has been challenging for everyone due to the pandemic. Shortly after the announcement of state-of-emergency, we quickly adapted to the situation and established virtual and phone consultation platforms to support our team and our clients in the community. Doing so minimized the risk for clients and created a safer working environment for our team. I am proud to say that everyone in the clinic has been very supportive. We continued to work hard and strive to stay connected with our clients. We continued to provide in-person visits for pregnant women, well baby appointments, and immunizations when deemed necessary by nurse practitioners. To assist the government vaccine roll out plan, we also provided individual check-ins regarding COVID-19 vaccine education to minimize hesitations from our clients. We have also revamped our community programs and adapted to a virtual platform, in order to continue to provide support for our community and to reduce social isolation for populations that are in need. In response to the increased demand on the healthcare system and to maintain continuity of care for clients with COVID-19, our clinic implemented a systematic COVID-19 monitoring program, COVID@Home Monitoring in Primary Care. It created the opportunity for clinicians to provide appropriate care, prevent emergency room visits, and support early detection of worsening cases. This year, through professional development programs from the clinic, I have also completed a management course with SickKids. I have always believed learning is a lifelong process. I will be able to utilize the knowledge and skills that I have acquired through the course to not only better lead the team, but ultimately empower and inspire one another. Special shout out to the amazing team in the clinic; with everyone's hard work, we continue to provide excellent care for our



Through challenging times and changes, we continue to grow as a team alongside the community. As every level of community and government work together, we will bounce back from this adversity and connect to become a stronger unit.



Some statistics about us this year

- We have registered a total of 3222 clients as of March 31st, 2021.
- We have hosted a total of 56 virtual workshops/seminars with a total of 992 participants between April 2020 to March 2021.
- We conducted a total of 1368 in-person appointments and 3428 phone consultations for our clients between April 2020 to March 2021.
- According to our patient satisfaction survey,
 - 97% of our clients would recommend our clinic to their family and friends
 - 98% of our clients rated their experience in our clinic as “good,” “very good” or “excellent”
 - 99% of our clients feel welcome in our clinic
